

# Holiday Homes

[vc\_row][vc\_column width="2/3?][vc\_column\_text]Our Holiday Homes are sited on level pitches. Set in 5 acres of immaculately maintained surroundings, Smithy Park has a garden-like appearance. The mature trees and shrubs in the neat grounds lead down to the River Severn. Each Holiday Home pitch has, patio, storage box, connection to all services including electric, piped gas and a cabled TV aerial with some satellite channels.

There is [free fishing on the River Severn](#) alongside the park, or day, weekly and season tickets available for 2 miles upstream, or on the adjoining [Montgomeryshire Canal](#). Fast water fishing includes Trout and Salmon. There are also Grayling, Chubb and other coarse fish.

The splendidly varied countryside is wonderful to look at and a paradise to walk in. The park has good access to the Montgomeryshire Canal towpath, ideal for walking and cycling and for dog owners. There is a small children's play area, with swings, slides and a climbing frame for the little ones to enjoy. The local [Community Centre](#) is a very short walk and has tennis courts, bowling green and other facilities available, with a small membership charge.

If you need more, then the local market town of [Newtown](#) has a lot to offer. It's just 5 minutes in the car or a regular bus journey from the park entrance. Supermarkets, The Bear Lanes Mall, recently renovated traditional Market Hall, boutiques and curio shops can serve your practical needs and provide some retail therapy. The Robert Owen museum, Oriel Gallery or Theatre Hafren should cater for your cultural and entertainment needs. [Welshpool](#) is another bustling market town, with everything from specialist shops to Farmers Markets. There's a steam railway, canal cruises and the famous Powis Castle nearby. The local town of Montgomery also has castle ruins and grounds with spectacular views over the countryside, well worth visiting.

The stunning Welsh coast is just an hour's drive away. Aberystwyth, Aberdovey, Borth, or a little further on, Aberaeron and Barmouth, the journey is a treat too as you take in the beautiful scenery en route. With convenient access to the North and Midlands, Smithy Park is handy for you to get away from it all.
