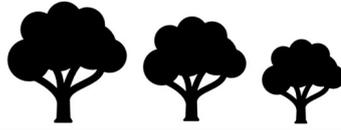


OAK COTTAGE

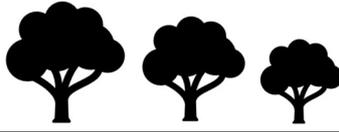

Evacuation procedure

On hearing the Fire Alarm leave the cottage by your nearest safe exit.

Don't stop to collect belongings.

Assemble at the meeting point in front of the cottage.

Make sure everyone is out and call 999.

Only stop to tackle the fire if safe to do so, do not re-enter the building.

There are nightlights / torches in the bedrooms and in the lounge, and the whole property is covered by radio linked smoke/heat/CO alarms for safety.

There is a fire extinguisher in the utility room, and a fire blanket hanging in the kitchen.

The external door in the double bedroom serves as a fire exit, while in the twin room there is an egress window fitted.

Please take a moment to familiarise yourselves with the layout and exits, and please don't remove the key from the patio doors.

APPLIANCES & MANUALS

Instruction Manuals for the washing machine, shower, microwave, central heating boiler and fire can all be found in one of the dresser drawers in the sitting room.

The water temperature is set on the boiler, and the central heating is best regulated by using the thermostat on the wall next to the dresser.

There is a guard to fit on the cooker when using the grill, this slides in on the 2 screws just inside the grill.

JUST A FEW DO's AND DON'Ts

We prefer Oak Cottage to remain non-smoking/non-vaping.

Pets are most welcome, but please don't allow them on the beds and furniture.

Please help us to keep the neighbours happy, and keep noise to a minimum.

Parking is to the front of the cottage.

Fishing is allowed on Smithy Park with an NRA licence, just pop in to reception to let us know that you are on the park, or to purchase a permit for further upstream.

Please let us know of any problems as soon as possible.

Once in Newtown, the train station is at Old Kerry Road, Newtown, Powys, SY161BP, and serves Aberystwyth, the Coast and Shrewsbury.

The Nags Head, Garthmyl, 01686 640600, holds several awards and is dog friendly.

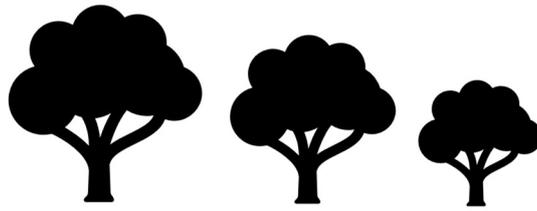
The Horseshoes Inn, Berriew, also dog friendly, 01686 640198.
